

Amelia Springs receives “Award of Excellence” from Julia Child

The American Institute of Wine and Food's founder and co-chairperson, Julia Child, presented Amelia Springs Mineral Water the “Award of Excellence” on October 14, 1991 at the Adirondacks Restaurant in Union Station, Washington, D.C.

To qualify, all applicants are pre-jury judged and limited to 30 companies. Amelia Springs Mineral Water was the only bottled water selected as one of the 30 finalists for the Marketplace Tasting.

The water has earned the “Virginia's Finest” designation from the Virginia Department of Agriculture and is the product water for Revlon's Visage Beaute' Cosmetics of Beverly Hills, California. Amelia Springs Mineral Water is sold in grocery and health food stores throughout the mid-east and south.
